Volunteer Opportunities at Planes of Fame Air Museum

Volunteers at Planes of Fame Air Museum are involved in almost every aspect of the Museum's operations. While most volunteer activities fall into several classifications, shown below, the Museum is also looking for people with specific skills and interest. All volunteers are required to complete this application, attend a volunteer orientation, and sign a personal liability waiver form before acceptance into the volunteer organization.

Brief Volunteer Job Descriptions

Museum Docent

Museum Floor Attendant: Scheduled and flexible shifts. Floor Attendants walk the museum floor and tarmacs, assist visitors by answering questions and providing help where needed. They assist with museum maintenance, security and safety. This position is our goodwill ambassador to the public. Training classes, Self-Study and On-the-Job Training is required.

Museum Tour Guide: Lead scheduled tours ranging from 45 minutes to 3 hours. Tour groups range from pre-school to senior adults. Training classes, Self-Study and On-the-Job Training is required.

Aviation Discovery Center (ADC): Scheduled and flexible shifts available. ADC Docents work with children of all ages to assist and supervise the static and interactive displays, including the flight simulators. ADC Docents conduct presentations and answer questions related to aviation technologies and aviation careers.

Education Outreach: Scheduled activity. As part of the Museum's Educational Outreach program, Docents assist by presenting aviation-related modules to school-aged groups visiting the Museum during field trips. Educational Outreach may also involve presentations conducted at school campus locations.

Library: Library staff participates in the categorization of books and periodicals and assist museum members in using the library for research purposes.

Other Volunteer Opportunities

Aircraft Detailer: Flexible hours on Saturdays initially with potential for weekday work. Detailers clean Museum displays including static and operational aircraft. Volunteers must attend additional training on how to detail aircraft and displays. This activity is an excellent opportunity for families with children too young for independent work. Your son or daughter can learn a lot while having fun keeping our aircraft and displays clean while you supervise.

Film & Post Production: Film special events such as living history flying events on the 1st Saturdays of each month. Periodically there will be other video projects around the Museum. All video will be computer edited and produced mainly as DVD output.
