Volunteer Opportunities at Planes of Fame Air Museum

Volunteers at Planes of Fame Air Museum are involved in almost every aspect of the Museum's operations. While most volunteer activities fall into several classifications, shown below, the Museum is also looking for people with specific skills and interest. All volunteers are required to be members of the museum, attend a volunteer orientation, and sign a personal liability waiver form before acceptance into the volunteer organization.

Brief Volunteer Job Descriptions

Museum Guides (Docent)

Museum Floor Attendant: Scheduled and flexible shifts. Floor Attendants walk the museum floor and tarmacs, assist visitors by answering questions and providing help where needed. They assist with museum maintenance, security and safety. This position is our goodwill ambassador to the public. Training classes, Self Study and On-the-Job Training is required. Floor Attendants must purchase a uniform shirt.

Museum Tour Guide: Lead scheduled tours ranging from 45 minutes to 3 hours. Tour groups range from pre-school to senior adults. Training classes, Self Study and On-the-Job Training is required. Tour Guides must purchase a uniform shirt.

Hands-On-Aviation center Attendant: Scheduled and flexible shifts available. HOAC attendants work with children of all ages and provide supervision, assist visitors to the HOAC using interactive and static displays, assist in the use of flight simulators, and answers questions on aviation technologies and careers.

B-17 & C-47 Attendant: Scheduled and flexible shifts available. This is an outdoor activity working at our B-17 and C-47 aircraft answering customer questions, giving tours, and raising funds for the restoration of the B-17. Training classes, Self Study and On-the-Job Training is required. Attendants must purchase a uniform shirt.

Gift Shop Attendant: Flexible shifts. Gift Shop volunteers assists customers, stock merchandise, and general cleaning. Volunteer t-shirt provided.

Other Volunteer Opportunities

Aircraft Detailer: Flexible hours. Detailers clean Museum displays including static and operational aircraft. Volunteer must attend additional training on how to work on aircraft. Uniform T-shirt provided. This activity is an excellent opportunity for families with children too young for independent work. Your son or daughter can learn a lot while having fun keeping our aircraft clean.

Film & Post Production: Film special events such as Living History Flying events on the 1st Saturdays of each month. Periodically there will be other video projects around the museum. All video will be computer edited and will be output mainly to DVD.

Library: While the library currently is only open on Saturdays, we are looking to expand the library's operational hours. Library staff participate in the categorization of books and periodicals and assist museum members in using the library for research purposes.

Note: While many of the museum volunteers are engaged in restoration of aircraft, Planes of Fame Air Museum is not currently looking for restoration volunteers other than licensed A&P's.
