



2018 Student Art Contest Official Rules

FORMAT: The required format is paper measuring 8.5" x 11". Artwork must not be framed or outlined with borders.

MEDIUM: All artwork must be done by hand (or, in the case of physically challenged children, using feet or mouth). Any of the following media are permitted: *Watercolor, acrylic, oil paint, indelible marker pens, felt-tip pens, soft ballpoint pens, indelible ink, crayon or other similar permanent medium.* The following media are not permitted: *pencil, charcoal or other non-permanent medium; computer generated artwork; collage work involving the use of photocopies, photographs, or printed materials.*

ENTRY DATA: Only one entry per person.

The following information should be provided on the back of the artwork:

1. Entrant's first and last name
2. Mailing address
3. Entrant's date of birth
4. Current grade level
5. Name and address of school where entrant attends
6. Teacher's name and phone number

A signed and dated *Certificate of Authenticity* (available for download from this webpage) must be included in the envelope along with the artwork submission.

REPRODUCTION RIGHTS: Once received, entries become (and remain) the property of the Planes of Fame Air Museum and may be used for a variety of marketing, merchandising, and promotional purposes.
