



## 2020 Student Art Contest Official Rules

**FORMAT:** The required format is paper measuring 8.5" x 11". Artwork must not be framed or outlined with borders.

**MEDIUM:** All artwork must be done by hand (or, in the case of physically challenged children, using feet or mouth).

Any of the following media are permitted:

*Watercolor, Acrylic, Oil Paint, Indelible Marker Pens, Felt-Tip Pens, Soft Ballpoint Pens, Indelible Ink, Crayon or other similar permanent medium.*

The following media are not permitted:

*Pencil, Charcoal or other non-permanent medium; Computer-Generated Artwork; Collage Work involving the use of photocopies, photographs, or printed materials.*

**ENTRY DATA:** Only one entry per person.

The following information should be provided on the back of the artwork:

1. Entrant's first and last name
2. Mailing address
3. Current grade level
4. Name and address of school where entrant attends
5. Teacher's name and phone number

A signed and dated *Certificate of Authenticity* (available for download from this webpage) must be included in the envelope along with the artwork submission.

**REPRODUCTION RIGHTS:** Once received, entries become (and remain) the property of the Planes of Fame Air Museum and may be used for a variety of marketing, merchandising, and promotional purposes.

# 2020 Student Art Contest Guidelines

Planes of Fame Air Museum, located in Chino, California is hosting an aviation-themed Student Art Contest. The contest is open to all children currently enrolled or home-schooled in Grades 1 thru 6. Entries will be judged in three groups according to grade level.

**JUDGING CATEGORIES:** *Group 1:* 1<sup>st</sup> Grade & 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade; *Group 2:* 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade & 4<sup>th</sup> Grade; *Group 3:* 5<sup>th</sup> Grade & 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

**THEME:** The theme for this year's contest is "**BLUE SKIES AHEAD!**" Entries will be judged for the creative use of this theme in their artwork as it relates to flight. Originality, artistic achievement, and interpretation of theme will all be considered in the judging.

**JUDGING:** Entries will be reviewed by a panel of judges. They will determine four semi-finalists for each group. These semi-finalist entries will then be judged by a second, independent panel to determine 1<sup>st</sup> Place, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place for each group. Winners will be notified (phone/email) and presentation of awards will take place at the February 6, 2021 "Living History" event at the Planes of Fame Air Museum.

**AWARDS:** Awards for First, Second, and Third place for each group will be presented. Prizes include:

**1<sup>st</sup> Place:** Certificate & Ribbon, Family Membership to Planes of Fame Air Museum, \$75 Gift Certificate for the Planes of Fame Air Museum Gift Shop, Framed reproduction of artwork

**2<sup>nd</sup> Place:** Certificate & Ribbon, \$50 Gift Certificate for the Planes of Fame Air Museum Gift Shop, Framed reproduction of artwork

**3<sup>rd</sup> Place:** Certificate & Ribbon, \$25 Gift Certificate for the Planes of Fame Air Museum Gift Shop, Framed reproduction of artwork

**DEADLINE:** All artwork must be postmarked no later than **FRIDAY, DECEMBER 18, 2020** or delivered to the Planes of Fame Air Museum Gift Shop no later than 5:00pm on FRIDAY, DECEMBER 18, 2020.
